Friday, March 6

- 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm** **Registration** – Held at the Penn Stater Conference Center Hotel, outside Dean’s Hall in the Senate Suite. All the contestants need to register and draw for their shooting position. Saturday breakfast (\$9.50) and awards banquet (\$19.00 Adults and \$13.00 for children 12 and under) tickets will be available to purchase during this time. The Drug Awareness table will also be setup and on display.
- 6:30 pm - 8:00 pm** **Get Acquainted Reception** – Contestants, their families and guests are invited to enjoy some pizza and soda, in Dean’s Hall next to registration.

Saturday, March 7

- 7:45 am** **Breakfast of Champions** – At the Penn Stater in the President’s Hall. Contestants will sit up front at their reserved tables. Everyone is welcome to attend. Those staying over Friday evening will receive two complimentary tickets per room. Additional tickets will be available Friday evening during registration. All late contestant registrations will be handled prior to breakfast.
- 8:45 am - 9:00 am** **Exit for the Gym** – Contestants, Directors, and Officials will be bussed to the gym.
- 9:00 am - 9:30 am** **Practice/Warm-up Time** – No one will be allowed in the gym prior to 9:00 am.
- 9:40 am - 10:10 am** **Opening Ceremonies** – Parade of Champions and introduction of special guests.
- 10:15 am - 2:00 pm** **Pennsylvania State “Hoop Shoot” Finals** – Held at the State College High School in the North Building Gym - The 8-9 age group will shoot first, followed by the 10-11’s and then the 12-13’s. First, second and third place medallions will be awarded after each contest. There will also be a ten minute intermission between contests.
- 4:00 pm - 6:30 pm** **Awards Banquet** – At the Penn Stater in the President’s Hall. All the contestants are urged to attend the Banquet. Each will be introduced and presented with a participation plaque. Contestants will again sit up front at the reserved tables. Everyone is welcome to attend, but again you must have a ticket. Additional banquet tickets will be available to purchase Friday evening during registration.
